



Quick Track Tuition Credit Program

School Year 2010-2011

To make a Schechter education available to a wider range of families, including those who previously would not have applied or qualified for Traditional Financial Aid, the Board of Trustees is pleased to offer an enhanced Quick Track Tuition Credit program. Families who meet the criteria below may apply for a tuition credit for each student enrolled at Schechter with a streamlined application process. The Quick Track program is not designed to replace the School's Traditional Financial Aid program. The Traditional program is available to families applying for financial aid in amounts larger than \$600 - \$3,000 per student.

As shown in the chart below, you will qualify for Quick Track Financial Aid if your 2009 adjusted gross income is less than \$300,000 and if your family's assets (excluding equity on primary residence and retirement accounts) are less than \$300,000. If you meet both of these criteria, please submit the Quick Track Tuition Credit application on the reverse of this page to Schechter's Financial Aid Office at 125 Wells Avenue, Newton MA 02459, no later than February 12, 2010. The Financial Aid Committee's decision will be mailed to you by March 19, 2010.

It is not necessary to submit both a Quick Track and a Traditional financial aid application. If you believe you will require more than financial aid than you would receive under the Quick Track program, please complete the Traditional financial aid application and submit the required supplemental materials. If you submit the Traditional application, we will determine your eligibility under both programs and will make a grant that is most advantageous within the guidelines. Please note that the deadline for all applications is February 12, 2010. Late applications will not be accepted.
